ACCREDITATION – Plymouth State University is accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. This accrediting body is the nationally recognized, non-governmental organization whose mission is to evaluate the quality and integrity of educational programs. A committee of college and university administrators and faculty from throughout New England spends considerable time evaluating schools seeking this accreditation. Institutions earning this accreditation are judged to be providing educational experiences that can be transferred to any other accredited college or university in the nation.

In addition to being accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, Plymouth State University is accredited by the New Hampshire State Board of Education. The professional education programs at Plymouth State University are accredited by the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE). This accreditation covers initial teacher preparation programs and advanced educator preparation programs. NCATE is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation to accredit programs for the preparation of teachers and other school personnel.

Program-specific accreditations include the following: social work program by the Council of Social Work Education; health education program by the Society for Public Health Education and the American Association for Health Education; athletic training program by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs of the American Medical Association; and the bachelor's degree programs in accounting, applied economics, business administration, management and marketing and the Master of Business Administration by the Association of Collegiate Business Schools and Programs. Master of Education in Counselor Education: Mental Health and School Counseling by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP). The Plymouth State University Nursing program is approved by the New Hampshire Board of Nursing.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE CALCULATION – A student's GPA is calculated only for credit earned at Plymouth State University. For a repeated course, only the last grade which carries grade points is used in the calculation. Repeated courses included in the GPA calculation will be marked with an "I". Courses repeated that are not included in the GPA calculation are marked with an "E".

COURSES ATTEMPTED – A student's transcript shows all courses attempted after the drop period.

ACADEMIC BANKRUPTCY – For students granted academic bankruptcy for the terms in which a bankruptcy was approved, the GPA is reset to 0.00, but credits are counted for courses in which a grade of C or better was earned and are marked with a grade of XC. Grades of less than a C will remain on the transcript and will be marked as "E" to exclude them from the GPA calculation.

TRANSFER CREDIT – The titles and credits, but not the grades, of transferred courses are recorded on the transcript. Only courses in which a grade of C or better or a P in Pass/No Pass courses are accepted in transfer. Transfer courses receive a grade of TR which counts towards hours earned but not GPA hours.

TRANSCRIPT VALIDATION – All official transcript are printed on Scrip-Safe® security paper and bear the signature of the University Registrar and the printed seal of Plymouth State University.
